

Safety Instruction Sheet Part 2 (Direct Observation of Shooter)

All members of the BBS Club Committee are authorised to act as H&S Range Safety Officers for the purposes of observing and reporting on *safe shooting practise and competence* as required by the National Rifle Association.

This sheet is the complement (Part 2) to the Club *Safety Instruction Sheet* which every shooting Club member must read and sign that he / she has understood and to which he / she will comply annually.

1	Person listens to Firers' Brief given by Range Officer		
2	Person recognises and acts accordingly in recognition of the authority of the Range Officer at all times		
3	Person takes gun to and from the firing point in an unloaded state and with bolt out or breech flag inserted.		
4	Person follows correct procedure in loading and firing, in particular only closing the bolt on a round when the rifle is pointing at the stop bank and including and maintaining safe elevation angles at all times when gun is loaded.		
5	Person shows correct "muzzle awareness" at all times.		
6	Person shows knowledge of correct misfire and rifle clearing procedure at all times.		
7	Person shows correct and safe procedure in the practice of zeroing his / her rifle		
8	Person demonstrates that he / she correctly maintains his / her rifle(s)
